I am objecting to the proposed development on the grounds that it will:

- obstruct our eastward looking view, especially in light of the proposed additional increases to the height of the building, which would mean it no longer fits in with neighbouring buildings and would dominate the skyline.
- change the overall look of the building, which is a landmark in a Conservation area

Having discussed it with my neighbours at Atlantic House, we all agree that the Council should consider more architectually appropriate and environmentally sustainable options for the proposed redevelopment without changing the character nor appearance of the building in any major way.

Given the above I would request that the applicant be asked to modify the application scheme in line with the suggestions set out in this email. If the suggestions are rejected for whatever reason, I would request that the application be refused on grounds of poor design, impact on the character and appearance of the Conservation Area and impact on adiacent residential amenity.
