Proposal:

Details pursuant to condition 12 (green roof details) following planning permission granted 16/8/2013 (2013/1820/P) for the demolition of existing retail showroom & flat (Class A1/C3), excavation to provide a basement level including a raised terraced area at rear, erection of new timber gate, all in connection with the creation of a 2 storey dwelling house (Class C3). Drawing Nos: 43 Belsize Lane - Green roof specification and maintenance; 100-05-C4; 521-05-C3; 522-03-C2.

The Council has considered your application and decided to grant permission.

Informative(s):

1 The proposal includes both an extensive green roof and a sedum green roof. The submitted details satisfactorily demonstrate that the green roof is suitably designed and secures measures for on-going maintenance. The green roof will improve the biodiversity value of the site.



As such, the proposed development is in general accordance with policies CS13, CS14, CS15 and CS16 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy, and policies DP22, DP23, DP24 and DP32 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies. The proposed development also accords with policies 5.3, 5.10, 5.11 of the London Plan 2011; and paragraphs 14, 17 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
