Re: Planning Application 2013/3807/P (Mount Pleasant, Gough and Calthorpe St) and Islington Council

In response to the consultation notice dated 26 June 2013.

I am against the proposal.

It is a significant overdevelopment of the sites. The scale and height of the new buildings seem out of proportion with the neighbourhood. With nearly 700 dwellings, presumably more than 2,000 people may live there. What consideration has there been of the impact on the area including transport links?

My concern extends to the proposals submitted to Islington Council.

I do not think the proposals as they stand should be approved. There should be a significant reduction in the scale, height and impact of the proposed development.
