We object to this application, on these grounds:

- 1. The enlargement of the so-called "mansard" roof at front and back of the house would damage its character, in this part of our Conservation Area. The drawings are presented to suggest that little alteration would result, especially on the front, street, elevation, due to the position of the parapet wall. This is misleading; the bringing-forward of the "mansard" wall, in order to enlarge the room behind by a very small amount, would alter its alignment and appearance substantially. It would no longer match the adjoining house, harming the original architecture of this short terrace.
- 2. The balcony at 2nd floor level, rear, would lead to unacceptable overlooking of the gardens and houses opposite, which are little more than 12 metres away.
