COMMENTS:

No35 was a single dwelling. .

I wish to reiterate that the issue that I have raised - which is that random, extrawagnat alterations to one house in an area with pronounced impact effects will have - basic nature dictates this - consequences for all houses on a similar or lower altitude contour line. I have not received any case having been made by the builders/constructors here which has evidence which can delete common experience. Further it cannot deny the actions taken by Thames Water some years ago were based on those experiences. There is no evidence from Thames Water that the actions and impact on this area are eased by what is being done. In that case the concerns of the occupier of no 33 must be accepted and acted on.
