## Dear Planning Department

We object to the removal of the Norway Maple at the above address on the following grounds.

1 Combined with the proposed removal of trees at 2 Merton Rise (planning application 2013/2849/T) the felling of this tree would completely expose the properties on King Henry's Road. The properties on Elsworthy Road would over look the flats and houses on King Henry's Road and diminish any privacy afforded by the tree canopy.

2. Whist this single tree may not provide significant habitats for wildlife, combined with the proposed removal of trees at 2 lower Metron Rise and the previous removal of planting and trees to accommodate studio buildings in gardens, the effect is sequential. The bird and wildlife population has significantly changed with the changing nature of the gardens which will be further compromised with the removal of this tree.

We hope you will consider these objections during the consultation process.
