The extension in question is above the only access to our property at the side of the building. We have our two grand-daughters to it on a regular weekly basis, aged 4 and six. They were greatly endangered last year by falling pieces of heavy building materials and plastic for the work being done to Mr Palan's apartment, apparently, and the debris was left uncollected. No apology was received. The proposed extension work would require scaffolding along our ally and would certainly increase the discomfort of our side entrance, while adding to the potential danger.

We therefore oppose the plans.
