The opportunity presented by the submission of the revised plans for Microtime / Pulse House has been used to tack on a number of other applications (for a roof terrace, balconies and lighting) which breach concepts systematically followed until now throughout the development.

The issues of:

- a) personal privacy
- b) intrusion
- c) light intrusion and pollution

have been raised by the Twyman House Construction Management Plan Working Group (THCMPWG) at every stage of the development. I am deeply concerned that the opportunity to do so again with the current set of applications has been denied before their submission to the Council. Why are basic principles governing the development now being ignored?

I urge the Council insist upon the application of these principles throughout the whole development until its completion.
