I am not sure whether the time for making representations on the above application has now expired.

If you are able, I would ask that you take account of my representations as follows.

1. I maintain the observations I have made in respect of the applicant's earlier application made for car access to the property (- in particular relating to the trees and to highway issues), in so far as these apply to the above application.
2. I ask that in the event that permission is granted for either or both applications, it is made a condition of each permission that the other development is not carried out i.e. in any event, the applicant should be permitted to pursue one only of the two options for car access for which he has applied for planning permission.

Finally, I ask that you take this email into account as a representation on the application. Let me know whether, as a matter of formality, I need to submit the content of this email in some other form – eg by way of submission through Camden's planning portal or by way of letter.
