this is notification of my intent to carry out tree work, after a 6-week notice period is fulfilled, as detailed below:

Site 1

Tree Species: 2 x *Tilia x europaea* (Lime trees)
Location: Both at front of premises - only tree species in front courtyard / garden.
Access: Can be viewed / inspected from the road
Work proposed: Fell and remove both trees
Reason for work: Private home owner adjacent to these trees is pursuing legal action due to damage to her driveway and gate. The private owner notes that their builder's report identifies the trees as the cause of cracking / ridges in the drive and movement in the gate-post preventing operation of the gate system.

Tree Species: 1 x *Tilia x europaea* (Lime tree)
Location: Sole tree specimen in rear garden.
Access: Can be viewed / inspected from the side road (Carol Street)
Work proposed: Reduce crown by 4m, remove dead wood
Reason for work: This tree is a mature specimen which contains some cavities and tight unions at the crown-break. It would be appropriate to contain the upper crown so that stress to the crown-break is limited as a safety precaution. Also the tree is very dense, and formative pruning work and a crown reduction will decrease the shading of the surrounding gardens.

I note commencement of the notice period to be tomorrow's date (08/05/2013).
