REAR GARDEN with no side access.

SELF-SOWN SYCAMORES - To left of decking area, trees likely to cause damage if left to develop. We advise: Fell as close as possible to ground level.

LARGE SYCAMORE - On right hand boundary, blocking light and air to garden. We advise: Lift crown to 4.5 metres all round and thin canopy by 25%.

LARGE ASH - On left hand boundary, tree leans at a sharp angle and has decay up and down its main stem. We advise: Fell as close as possible to ground level.

SMALLER ASH - Adjacent, blocking light and air to garden. We advise: Thin crown 20% removing deadwood.
