					I'm writing in response to your letter regarding planning application ref.1024/3365/P for The Assembly House, 292 Kentish Town Road NW5 2TG.
					I must object to the Assembly House's proposed plans carry out renovation work; particularly to install stronger extrator fans. They recently installed new fans two or three years ago (in 2011 or 12) and the new fans are are much noisier than before. Also, when they installed the fans, the pub used the front path of 1 Leighton Road NW5 2QD (between the gate and the front door) to remove the old fans without asking permission. They left a lot of rubble and I had to visit the pub to complain three times before the mess was cleared up. I also experienced a lot of problems with noise on Sundays. For three weeks in a row, work would start at 8am. It was so noisy that nobody could hear to answer the door at the pub; the council offices are closed on Sundays and the automated response for out-of-hours service was too slow to help me deal with the problem. Greene King took three weeks to ask the contractor to intervene. He apologised and the Sunday work stopped for one week and then resumed until the work was complete.
					It might sound as though this was an isolated incident but I've had repeated bad experiences trying to communicate with indifferent Assembly House staff, even when Greene King has tried to help. Therefore, I'm unwilling to give the thumbs-up to this plan.
