I OBJECT in the strongest possible terms to the above applications.</p> <p>During that time it has been an ongoing battle with the developers of the St Giles Hotel site. Their over intensification and commercialization of this space has been epic, without any consideration for its neighbours in the very residential area.</p> <p>I am amazed how lightly Camden deal with their never ending breaches of planning and licensing, indeed the judicial review this last January was it, found against them in almost every respect. They had also applied for use of the public footpath for tables and chairs, it is was turned down.
