I have viewed the planning documents and appreciate that Camden's planning officers will satisfy themselves that the submission proposal meets planning requirements and officers' pre-application advice(or not. This said, I wish to make just one general comment about this application: So far as I'm aware this proposal, if built, would become the first of this 'deep extended-basement type' to affect the neighbourly character of this conservation area. Firmly established as a type in other wealthier mono-class areas of London it should be refused for it's possible precedent-setting characteristics. One of the clear benefits of this 'Rochester' area is that, to some extent, it still remains a socially healthy mixed-class neighbourhood. Were this proposal to be approved I suggest that with more of the same that would probably follow this precedent, the character of the area would, by market erosion, be harmed. This should be resisted and the proposal should be refused.
