We live in the next door but one property and the tree is clearly visible from all our first and second floor rear windows. We feel that the loss of the tree, which has been there for many years and appears to be in good health, should be resisted as it is of a high amenity value not just to all the neighbouring properties, but also to the general public as it adds to the sylvan quality of King Henry's Road. It has been successfully pruned in the past to reduce its shading of the garden of No 32, and we would much prefer that this policy be continued rather than removing the tree altogether.

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
