Proposal to use 8% reflectivity glass as per samples sent to Alex McDougall instead of 2% reflectivity glass

2% reflectivity glass is a very specialist material which is not available in the sheet sizes to suit the proposed rooflight and the cost of 2% glass would make the scheme unworkable. Glazing subcontractors Culmax advise 8% reflective glass is usually adequate to prevent detrimental impacts of light spillage or glare to adjoining properties
