## **Listed Building Consent Refused**

## Proposal:

Internal and external alterations to include the erection of a 2 storey side extension at lower and ground floor level with associated side entrance and external stair, removal and addition of internal partitions and doors.

The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** listed building consent for the following reason(s):

## Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed extension, by reason of its siting, design and form, would undermine the harmony and symmetry of the pair of listed buildings and would harm the internal plan form of No.11. This would fail to preserve the special historic and architectural interest of the listed building, contrary to policy CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development



Framework Core Strategy; and policy DP25 (Conserving Camden's heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
