Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed extension, by reason of its siting, design and form, would undermine the harmony and symmetry of the pair of buildings and thus harm the character and appearance of the conservation area, contrary to policy CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy; and policies DP24 Securing high quality design and DP25 (Conserving Camden's heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
