I am a partially disabled person who has lived in Flat i for over 12 years. My home is so terribly important to my welfare and physiological well-being, especially on medical grounds. I greatly fear the following should this applicaton be seriously considered by your authority:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Total lack of privacy for me whilst using the two most important rooms of my home, the bathroom and kitchen. both these rooms are in direct line of the proposed application. By erecting a skylight facility will impact directly onto my private existence in my flat. 2. The planned roof terrace at the rear will also impact seriously on my life. Any gathering of any size which congregate on this terrace will have a massive effect on the exisitng calm and serenity which has been in existence at the rear of this property since I moved to the area. This must not be permitted under any circumstances. This is a private and reserved area with many residents on both side of the property in question being of retirement age and beyond. Unsocial behaviour will undoubtedly prevail should this be allowed. Previous tenants in this falt behaved in a gross and unacceptable manner, weekend after weekend. On many occassions the police and environmental health offices have had to be called out to issue warnings to the tenants. Loud music and disturbance continued past 3am each weekend night. It seriously disrupted my sleep pattern which has not fully recovered as yet. 3. Regarding the lighting facility being planned it must be reasonable to assume that the individual with responsibility for investigating this application at your authority will not doubt be aware that such lighting will directly and seriously impact the exisiting privacy to at least 6 private properties. This in my view is unacceptable and unethical. 4. I understand that the property in question is a 3 bedroomed flat. Will the authority include the issue of "parking" in St Albans Road in view of the possible 3 individuals moving into to Flat B at No 10? Currently I have tremendous problems in finding a disabled bay close by when I'm being driven? <p>In summary, my objection is firm and resolute. My health, (poor as it is) is my priority. Substantial medical evidence can be produced to support the importance of my objection. In addition, I'm willing to listen to the authorities position on this application and to any crucial alterations which you may wish to make to the application in light of the facts above.</p> <p>Finally, since I'm partially disabled with the added fact of slight mental health issues, I wish to let you know that my confidant and friend Peter Macnamee will be supporting me with communications on this matter.
