Introduction

The purpose of this report is to demonstrate the degree of visibility of the proposed residence and its impact on the setting and character of The Heath, both in daytime and in the evenings from possible light spillage.

It is evident that the property is all but invisible from The Heath when the surrounding woods are in full leaf. The photos therefore used are taken in early April 2014, when the deciduous leaf cover was minimal, to be better able to judge any impact during the seasons of least foliage cover.
