Assessment

Proposal:

- 1.1 Advertisement consent is sought for the display of Scimitar Outdoor Ultra Slim 6 sheet LED light box unit. The proposed advertisement would be displayed in an existing south facing glass panel on the existing bus stop. The casing would be aluminium base profile containing LEDs lighting panel with hinging aluminium front cover profile.
- 1.2 The overall dimension is approximately 1.3m (width) x 1.8m (height), the lettering would be 0.75m, the illuminance level would be $400\text{-}600\text{cd/m}^2$, the signage is displayed through approximately six sheet paper of approximately 170gram that are enclosed within the polycarbonate glass that would change on a regular basis and the proposed signage would rotate ever four to five minutes and would change the proposed sheet to be displayed.
- 1.3 The Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) Regulations 2007 permits the Council to only consider amenity and public safety matters in determining advertisement consent applications.

Setting

1.4 The sign does not obscure any special architectural features or setting as it's not located on a building and the bus stop is of no architectural merit.

Visual Amenity

- 1.7 The sign would be located in the existing glass pane facing the oncoming traffic driving south towards Goodge street Station due to the illuminance 400-600cd/m² it is not considered that the proposed sign would impact on the neighbouring amenities nor it is envisaged that due to the size and scale of the proposed sign there would be an impact on the highway. Therefore, the proposal would be acceptable to planning policies CS14, DP24 of the LDF.
- 1.8 It is considered that the sign would not be unduly obtrusive in the street scene or to neighbouring properties or occupiers.

Public Safety

2.0 The location of the signage is considered harmful to either pedestrian or vehicle traffic. The proposal therefore raises no public safety concerns.

Recommendation:

Grant Advertisement consent
