The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The proposed first and second floor side extension, by reason of its height, bulk, mass, location and detailed design, would be detrimental to the character and appearance of the building and the wider Fitzjohns Netherhall Conservation Area, contrary to policy CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policies DP24 (Securing high quality design) and DP25 (Conserving Camden's



heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
