Re: Erection of Roof terrace at 138 Goldhurst Terrace, NW6 3HR. Application Ref 2014/3922/P

This association objects in the strongest possible terms to the above application which proposes a design of loft conversion which has never previously been allowed by Camden.

CRASH objects to any increase in roof height, alteration to the roof profile or extension of the parapet wall height since it would radically alter the architectural character of an entire row of terraced houses in a street in a Conservation Area protected by Article 4. Furthermore, this proposal completely disregards the regulations of Camden's Core Strategy 2010.

The proposal shows no understanding of, or sympathy for, the architectural heritage of the neighbourhood and if such an application were permitted in would set a precedent which will allow other developers to destroy the harmonious character of the streetscape of this Conservation Area for ever.

CRASH respectfully asks you to refuse this application.
