Your comments on the planning application: I understand the applicant wants to enlarge the window which I believe to be on the first floor. If this window leads on to the flat roof of the extension, I would just like to be sure that this is not the prelude to using the flat roof as a roof-terrace.

The houses in York Way and Marquis Road are close together and the gardens are already overlooked. We have had great trouble with noisy gatherings on roof-terraces up and down the two streets, particularly as more and more houses are let to large groups of tenants. The proximity of the houses seems to magnify the noise, which can carry on through the night. My house backs on to the house next door to 93 and I would lose significant privacy in my garden if the flat roof were to become a roof-terrace. But what bothers me most is the risk of yet more noise. So while I have no objection to the enlargement of the window, I would be very unhappy if this were then turned into a door providing access to the flat roof. I would immediately object if this happened.
