We are writing on behalf of the Camden Town CAAC.

We strongly protest about this application.

To begin with, the fascia and projecting sign are already **up** and in place. Have you already approved this application, which we only received yesterday? Our CAAC has the right to comment before you make your decision.

We do not object to the design of the fascia but we do strongly object to its **virulent** colour. We appreciate that green is the Co-op's colour but this green is very loud and dominant - especially as it stands out in an historic street in our Conservation Area. It is also visible from Albert Street.

Central Camden Town is a Conservation Area and should be treated as one. This would not be allowed in Hampstead.

Please let us know what you intend to do.
