I am writing to oppose application reference 2013/7308/NEW, 97 A South Hill Park - 2014/5606/T -- the proposed felling of a cyprus tree on the boundary between 97 and 99 South Hill Park.

Removal of this tree would expose all the rear-facing windows of 99 South Hill Park to one of the busiest sections of the heath. This would constitute a drastic reduction in privacy for all residents of 99 South Hill Park. This tree provides a much needed shield from the busy heath.

Second, the tree provides a home to many different species of birds, insects, and other small creatures. At a time when biodiversity is under contestant threat, it seems truly irresponsible to remove a healthy, mature tree such as this one.
