**Subject:** 2014/5623/T tree works at 10 Jeffreys Street

I refer to your notification of a proposal to fell a Greengage Tree (Prunus) in the garden of 10 Jeffreys Street (Your ref 2014/5623/T)

I write to OBJECT to the proposed felling on the grounds that the work is directed towards the wrong tree. The Greengage in question is a small tree which if properly managed would be suitable in scale for the garden and a valuable addition to the natural resource.

The problem is the large Willow in the same garden which the owners have failed to manage and which, by virtue of its rapid and sizeable growth forces other trees into a distorted shape.

I hope the Tree Section will refuse permission to fell the Prunus but instead require the owners to cut back the Willow to a scale suitable to their garden and to manage the Prunus so that it grows in a balanced manner avoiding annoyance to their neighbours
