Please process an application to pollard the trees you can see in the attached photos, the Weeping Willow and shorter Crack Willow to the right of the Weeping Willow. Please pay particular attention to photo 1674, which potentially shows a small lighter green tree between the willows, which I didn't identify. We are looking to remove 30% of the canopy of the weeping willow, and given its resilient species feel this work would be suitable. We would like to remove roughly 4m from the extent of the branches of the shorter crack willow so probably 40% crown reduction. It is very crowded with trees in this little bit of garden that they call "the canal strip".
