The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

#### Reason(s) for Refusal

- 1 The proposed insertion of a door would fail to preserve and enhance the character and appearance of the shopfront, the building and the wider Hatton Garden Conservation Area. This is contrary to policy CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policies DP24 (Securing high quality design) and DP25 (Conserving Camden's heritage) of the Local Development Framework.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
