Boundary Treatments

Secured by Design principles have informed the boundary treatments. The existing brick wall on the eastern boundary will be retained and increased to a height of 2.4m where necessary in order to from the secure boundary. The north and west façades of the school building and No.1 Hawley Road provide the secure boundary to the site, linked by 2.4m high railings and gated access. The existing 0.5m high brick wall running alongside Hawley Road is retained with 1m steel railings on top of this.

Internal boundaries are limited to a 3m weld mesh fencing around the MUGA and a 1.2m high fence dividing the MUGA/playground from the reception and nursery external learning spaces. The external learning spaces to reception, nursery and Years 1-3 will have a more permeable separation from surrounding areas marked by clusters of timber posts at varying heights.
