

I object to this planning application for a number of reasons.

A roof extension on top of the highest and bulkiest building will overshadow and dominate the area.

The proposed works will lead to the demolition of the chimneys and stucco which are part of local architectural heritage.

The materials proposed are totally out of character e.g. aluminium and wood

and will have a negative impact.

The balconies will lead to lack of privacy for neighbours and do not respect the local character of the area.

There is insufficient provision for recycling/refuse for potentially 18 residents and the commercial business of the pub.

There is a real lack of parking already - will make the problem considerably worse.

Not enough bicycle storage provision.

As is evident from the Design and Access Statement this proposal has no respect for context and local heritage and is contrary to Camden's Core strategy CS14 and should be rejected.
