Refusal of Non Material Amendments to planning permission

Address:

Guinness Court St Edmund's Terrace London NW8 7QE

Proposal: Non-material amendment to approved permission 2010/4850/P for conversion of ground floor cycle store to porter's lodge and relocation of cycle store to basement car park.

Drawing Nos: Site location plan; 20-01 Rev A; 20-02; 20-03; 20-04; 20-05; proposed basement cycle parking alternative D.

Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed amendment would result in a material change to the accessibility of the cycle store and therefore cannot be considered 'non-material' to the original planning permission 2010/4850/P granted 13/12/2010.

Informative(s):

The proposed basement cycle store would provide poor access for cyclists and would not be supported if a s73 application (minor material amendment) were to be submitted. A suitable alternative location should be investigated or the cycle store



should remain in the location shown on approved drawing 20-01 Rev A.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
