The intention is to reduce the trees in front of 30 Compayne Gardens back to the most recent pruning point (approximately two years ago). They have grown back significantly since then.

For the two trees outside 28 Compayne Gardens, the intention is for a crown reduction and a 30-40% crown thinning - in accordance with the advice of the Arborist (Tree Matters Ltd.). They have not been pruned for over ten years, are over 20 metres high and now block all light to the front of the property.

Recently Flat 2, 30 Compayne Gardens experienced a major drain blockage and the drainage consultant believed the roots of the trees were in part to blame. One of the drain outlets is within 2 metres of two of the trees identified for pruning in this application (as identified on the sketch plan)
