
TREES TO BE RETAINED DURING DEMOLITION:

 To the East of the entrance to the shop there is an established tree within the existing pavement and located approximately 4 metres from the site boundary (see drawing 489-07-G). There are no other trees on or near the site. The rear boundary wall has an ivy growing over the full length of this wall. All vegetation to this boundary will be removed.

SEQUENCE OF EVENTS:

- a) Location and isolation of underground services.
- b) Assembly of temporary fences.
- c) Demolition of existing structure.
- d) Digging of basements.
- e) Main construction phase.
- f) Dismantling of temporary fences.
- g) Landscape works.

489-TW shows the position of two temporary fences assembled prior to any demolition works on site. These fences will stay in place until all site works are completed. The area enclosed is known as the Construction Exclusive Zone (CEZ).
