Please find enclosed an application for the discharge of Condition 2 of planning permission ref. 2012/6338/P (issued 25 April 2013).

Condition 2 states:

"Sample panels of all the facing brickwork demonstrating the proposed colour, texture, face-bond and pointing shall be provided on site and approved in writing by the local planning authority before the relevant parts of the works are commenced and the development shall be carried out in accordance with the approval given. The approved panels shall be retained on site until the work has been completed."

A site visit took place on 8 September 2014 where the bricks detailed in this submission were provided for inspection by the local authority.
