The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 02 June 2014 and decided to **OBJECT** for the following reasons:

Reasons for objection:

- 1 The mature lime tree is visible from the public realm on Arlington Road and forms part of green corridor along the rear gardens of Gloucester Crescent. It also provides screening of an industrial site to a number of properties in the area. The reasons given for felling the tree include blocking of light which is not considered sufficient reason to justify felling the tree. The application also suggests that the tree might cause structural damage in the future which is not considered sufficient reason to justify felling of the tree. A tree preservation order has been served to protect the character of this part of the conservation area.




A Tree Preservation Order has been served on the tree/s and no work should be carried out without the prior consent of the Council.
