Proposed Work:

FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Lime - Reduce crown by 25%. Thin crown density by 20%. Remove dead wood. Raise crown over road by approximately 3M.

1 x Norway Maple - Reduce crown back from building to clear by 2M. Reduce to separate from adjacent purple plum. Raise crown over road and pavement by 2M. Remove dead wood throughout crown. Thin crown density by 20%. Reduce lateral and sub-lateral growth by 20%

REAR GARDEN: Row of Cypress Hedge. - Fell to ground level.

Mixed species Conifer Hedge - Fell to ground level

1 x Willow - Fell to ground level.

5 x Yucca - Fell to ground level.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 30 July 2014 and does not wish to object.

- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is completed, whichever is the sooner.



- 2 You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS 3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these standards may result in damage to the tree(s) and may result in legal action by the Council.
- 3 Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife.
