## **DECISION**

OBJECTION TO SECTION 211 NOTICE OF WORKS TO TREE/S IN A
CONSERVATION AREA

Description:

FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Sycamore - Fell.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 11 August 2014 and decided to **OBJECT** for the following reasons:

## Reasons for objection:

This large, mature sycamore tree is highly visible from the public realm and is considered to significantly contribute to the character of this part of the conservation area. The tree is considered to be of high amenity value and to have a long useful life expectancy. The tree does have dual leaders with an area of included bark at its base but this is not considered to automatically render the tree unsuitable for a tree preservation order.

The setting of seed and the casting of shade are not considered to be sufficient reason to warrant the felling of a tree. Another nearby tree dropping a branch is not considered to be of relevance to this tree as every individual tree grows differently. If the foliage is low enough to touch vehicles it is likely that if an application were to be submitted to lift the canopy it is likely the application



would be approved.

A Tree Preservation Order has been served to protect the visual amenity the tree provides and to preserve the character of this part of the conservation area.

A Tree Preservation Order has been served on the tree/s and no work should be carried out without the prior consent of the Council.
