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Dear Karen,  
I submitted an objection to Planning application 2014/4257/P just before last Thursday's deadline.  
This is just to let you know I slightly updated it today and would prefer it if you used today's version.

Actually, the main difference is that I have now found that in CPG 6 Amenity - 7.4 below that suggests 18m as the minimum distance between facing windows. As my crucial bedsit window is well under 6m from the proposed dormer, it is 3 times too close and would appear 9 times larger than the recommended minimum (by the inverse square law)

I hope you can use the updated version.

Camden Planning Guidance CPG 6 7.4 WHAT IS GOOD PRACTICE?  
To ensure privacy, there should normally be a minimum distance of 18m between the windows of habitable rooms of different units that directly face each other.



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
