I am writing to ask you to help with the above. I live next door to this tree, which is approximately 50 years old and it would be a tragedy to lose it. It does need severe pruning, since it has not been done for many years, but my neighbours and I feel very strongly about keeping this tree - we have already lost too many trees in King Henrys Road (which is at the back of Elliott Sq).

Someone mentioned to me that its condition has been used as a reason for felling the tree ... however, you only have to look at the tree to see how healthy it is and, since I live right next to it, I have been able to monitor it over the last eight years and there is absolutely nothing wrong with it. No 32 Elliott Square has just been sold and it is the new owners who have made the application.

Please investigate and help in saving this tree, which is so important to the environment and to so many people in the street. Please let me know if there is anything I can do - I am prepared to do whatever it takes to save this tree.
