Our house at 26 Swains Lane, N6 6QR is obliquely behind 10 St Albans Road with a clear view of the rear of the building. We are writing to object to the plans to alter the top 2 floor on the following grounds:

1. Loss of privacy to all surrounding gardens, flats and houses.
2. Noise nuisance.

The area that would be affected is currently a peaceful collection of back gardens not overlooked in this way. This proposed roof terrace would jeopardise the peace & life quality for the surrounding houses and flats.

We therefore request that the council rejects the roof terrace proposal.
