# Front boundary. Centre

Hornbeam 1

(Carpinus betulus) Very large mature widespreading specimen and feature tree. Carrying overlong and heavy lateral limbs all round and especially over the road(s). In order to: Contain spread, lessen weight on lateral branch ends pre-empting potential for limb-shedding and to improve light and space all round and general condition and safety:

> Reduce back middle and lower crown lateral spread over the roads - Belsize Park and Belsize Square by 25-30% (3-4m) to suitable new growing points. Reduce back lateral spread towards the front elevation by 1-2m to previous reduction points, retain crown continuity. Thin and clean out crown, remove deadwood, weak and suppressed branches. Lift canopy all round by up to 2m to improve clearance and level off 'browse line'. Balance

#### Rear garden left side corner

2 Evergreen Magnolia

(Magnolia grandiflora) Mature tree leaning strongly into the centre of the garden and taking over. To contain spread and improve light and space:

Remove back to the main trunk the low secondary limb extending out over the garden. Reduce and reshape main crown by 25-30% to previous reduction points, retain crown continuity. Thin and clean out crown, remove deadwood, weak and suppressed branches, lift and balance crown.


