



Dear Rachel

I am writing to you to object to the proposed erection of a roof extensions to form a 2 bedroom flat on top of 7-9 Perrins Court in Hampstead. My mother-in-law, Annette Rose and I rent the shop on 16 Perrins Court, right opposite the mentioned property and it would affect us greatly.

The proposed roof extension will make it even darker and not as appealing for pedestrians to walk through. The loss of light would be detrimental for business. We also believe that Perrins Court would loose it's character, charm and ambience and become a 'tunnel' rather than a 'shopping street' full of independent shops and cafe's.
