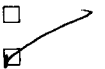

This is a quiet residential street, full of young families, surrounded by primary schools which walk down it in crocodile frequently. Young offenders are unsuitable neighbours in this context.

From the beginning we have suffered from extreme noise, often at night — either from sound systems blaring or from stroked abuse + swearing in the street. The staff in the office are often resentful + surly when we complain. Cigarette butts litter the street + he steps up to the building. Once a young inmate was observed climbing out of a top floor window, attempting to steal the lead piping, onto the roof.

We are sorry for the inmates. We have heard them complaining to each other about the squalid conditions in the building.

There is no 'pathway' or support of any kind to help them to a new and more fulfilling start in life. The 'business' is officially wound up, + yet is charging large sums — to make a profit + not to benefit its poor young 'clients'.

We have seen one young woman inmate led away from the building ~~by force~~ in handcuffs, by police, and a young man escorted away ~~by~~ by police officers.

We already have St. Mungo's in this road. It is a model, + a contrast with no 20. It is a charity, entirely run for the benefit of those it cares for. The staff are receptive to our comments + always helpful in their response. Enormous efforts are made to help + rehabilitate all those in the house. And those people are colourful but polite + respectful, quiet, friendly neighbours, unlike the inmates at no 20.
