I am commenting on the planning application for Ventra House specifically the landscaping opposite Ventura House element.

Please note from the enclosed photo's that this small square where there are over 40 residential homes and a commercial premises namely Nando's is being used as a Rubbish dumping area.

5 large commercial Refuse bins are located OUTSIDE OF THE MAIN FRONT ENTRANCE TO 17 HOMES at 308 Kilburn High Road on Palmerston Road. With two more large commercial waste bins opposite and is used as a A DUMPING GROUND FOR LOCAL BUSINESSES.

This situation poses A SERIOUS HEALTH HAZARD for residents and passers by many of whom are children accessing in the Vebbeath estate. This matter also causes undue emotional stress for residents whose main door and windows open out onto open refuse bins. Environmental health are currently investigating this matter.

Landscaping a grassy area is inappropriate use of council funds when all around there is open waste and refuse being dumped when the solution is obviously designated housing for refuse bins which are secured for use of tenants only.

Would it not be more logical efficient and users friendly for you to devise an appropriate plan for secure housing for refuse and both commercial and residential waste to improve the appearance and emotional welfare of people living locally.

This type of refuse arrangement would not be tolerated in Hampstead Heath or Belzize Park and we too pay council taxes.

I therefore recommend the planning department liaise with environmental services and readjust their priorities to focus on a rethink of the areas environmental factors alongside the emotional and social needs of local residents.
