It has not been erected so far between the house and the large tree on the 139 side of the garden, although from the plan it seems that it is part of the application for this to be done. Were they to erect this section, this would have a serious impact on the views and aspect from our patio and garden.</p> <p>We would like to object to the trellis on the grounds that it is simply too high and unsightly and we are strongly opposed to the length between the house and the tree on the 139 side in particular</p> <p>We also believe that the extent of the proposed sun shade is excessive and will look quite out of keeping with the style of house and will be ugly. Worse, it is likely that such an extent of sun shade will not be stable and will potentially flap in the wind and look even worse.</p> <p>The overall extension that has been built is extremely large and out of keeping with the style of the houses in the street, particularly with the huge plate glass windows that are completely at odds with the style of the building.</p> <p>We therefore object to this aspect of the planning application as it relates to the sun shade.</p>
