This site backs onto Market and Ruspini Houses and is very close to their bedrooms and mine at number 8. The open area between Parker and Great Queen Street already suffers from huge noise issues from extractors, ac, heat exchange units as well as coolers for Philomena's. It is completely unreasonable to add to such units especially for a unit which does not sound like a proper restaurant. moreover to ask for such a unit to be open and for its extractor to be in use throughout is crazy. I start work early and therefore am in bed by 10pm. We already have Philomenas humming away past 11pm. Please do not add to this. Also no assurances seem to be given re noise levels. Nor do Camden have the resources to monitor this, once granted. A heat exchange unit for the Cornershop office was granted 24/7 operation, exceeds noise levels and creates disturbance for some neighbours yet the onus is on us not the council to prove this. Please do not allow this to add to our noise issues. If there must be an extractor, please ask why and if essential, please limit to absolute quietest levels between 9am and 6pm Monday to Friday only. Many thanks
