As one of only two mature trees in the this whole length of terrace it provides a significant local amenity. The tree provides a welcome relief from the mass of properties on Camden Road, masking their oppressive height from the lower properties on Camden Mews; it introduces welcome visual, colour, movement and seasonal variety as well as a habitat for local fauna. As such its removal would constitute a significant loss to local residents. The (non-resident) applicant does not suggest that the tree is causing any damage or threat to any buildings. The only structure affected is the boundary wall to the adjoining rear garden. This wall does not appear to be severely affected at present and any minor effects that are present could be easily mitigated by far less drastic interventions - either replacing the small section of wall in the immediate vicinity of the tree with a timber fence, or possibly be pruning those parts of the tree that are impacting upon this structure.
