I am writing in connection with the proposed development. I should like to register my objection to the possibility of The Council granting planning permission for this development to go ahead. There is no question that the building phase will cause considerable disruption to an already congested Finchley Road and surrounding streets. The planned 2 year construction phase will produce noise and air pollution.
