Dear Sir

Following on from the successful campaign that overturned an owner's right to build a basement in Quadrant Grove in Kentish Town we feel that our opposition to the plans for 65 Compayne Gardens are even more valid.

We wrote a letter on 7 October 2014 with our objections.

65 Compayne Gardens is a much larger structure than the small property in question in Kentish Town. It therefore follows that the application to build a basement at 65 Compayne Gardens should, if it has not already been done so, be viewed as major works requiring full planning permission. As plans to build a basement in the terraced house in Kentish Town have been overturned it seems clear to us that such an extension for 65 Compayne Gardens would be even more unsuitable. The property is too large for such a renovation and would cause massive disturbance in the street while the works were taking place.
